

## Chicken Little Accordion Album

### Layer 1

- Ink edges of (2) 3 ½" x 12" Circle Patterned pieces.
- Fold the pieces into four equal segments.

### Layer 2

- Use temporary adhesive to adhere each end of (2) 3 ½" x 11" Light Blue Patterned pieces to the back of the (2) 3 ½" x 12" Circle Patterned Pieces.
- Fold layer 2 pieces in half. If not folded in half your accordion book will not line up properly. Then fold again into fourths.

### Layer 3

- Use temporary adhesive to adhere each end of (2) 3 ½" x 10" Red Stripe pieces to the back of the (2) 3 ½" x 11" Light Blue Patterned pieces.
- Fold layer 3 pieces in half. If not folded in half your accordion book will not line up properly. Then fold again into fourths.
- You should have 2 equal segments of accordion folded with 3 layers each. There should be equal spaces between each layer.

### Window 1

- Take pieces apart carefully.
- Using 2 ½" x 3" chipboard pattern trace onto the center of the first and fourth folds of the 3 ½" x 12" Circle Patterned pieces.
- Cut out windows with Exacto knife.

### Window 2

- Using 2" x 2 ½" chipboard pattern trace onto the center of the first and fourth folds of the 3 ½" x 11" Light Blue Patterned pieces.
- To center properly it helps to place Window 1 over the top of 3 ½" x 11" Light Blue Patterned pieces.
- Cut out windows with Exacto knife.

### Last Steps

- Permanently adhere edges of layers back together.

- Fold 1" x 3 1/2" Red Stripe piece in half vertically and permanently adhere to the back of layer 3 pieces. This will be the only piece holding the entire booth together.
- Decorate the Accordion Book as you please with provided Piggy Tales' Barndoors, Chipboard Letters, Cardstock Letter Stickers and remaining Cardstock Paper.
