

## You and Me Tin

### Needed Supplies for You & Me Tin:

Metal adhesive (modge podge, Mono by Tombo, Tacky Adhesive by 3M)

Glue Dots

Heavy Duty Scissors or tweezers to take of handle

Black pen for outlining

Corner Rounder or scissors

### Product in Tin Kit:

Green pattern piece for top of lid

(2) stripe pieces

(2) ¼" x 12 stripe pieces to be cut into (6) 2" pieces for flowers

(1) square pattern piece

(4) green pattern pieces

(4) white pieces

(1) solid blue piece

(2) red squares

(1) 3x6 pattern piece for leaves & stem

Cream, blue, red ribbon

You & Me stamped letters

(1) blue flower pattern piece to cut (2) small flowers for center of large flowers

Step 1: Adhere white pieces to bottom of tin. Start w/ the 1<sup>st</sup> piece in the center front of the tin. Adhere green pattern pieces to top edges of white pieces. Cut (4) ½" pieces from stripe paper. Keeping the lid closed and adhere to top edge of green pattern pieces.

Step 2: Adhere largest red square to bottom right edge of tin. Overlap solid blue paper. Adhere square pattern piece approx. ½" from bottom edge of blue paper. Using heart pattern trace & cut red cardstock & chipboard. Adhere red heart to chipboard heart. Then, adhere to tin. Cut out the stamped you and me words and mat with the remaining stripe paper that the words were on. Using black pen write "and" to the right of the heart. Tie knots in ribbon & adhere with glue dots to front of tin (The color copy shows different ribbon, so tell them to use the cream & blue ribbon provided instead).

### Step 3: Flowers

Using the 3x6 green pattern piece cut out (4) circle from the patterns on the paper. Fold the circles in half and outline. These folded pieces are the leaves. Cut (2)  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 3" pieces from the green pattern piece for the stems. Adhere the stems and the leaves to the tin.

Using (2)  $\frac{1}{4}$  x 12 stripe pieces cut (12) 2" pieces. For each flower fold the pieces alternating the stripe & brown sides. Adhere the folded pieces to the tin. Cut out (2) flowers from the blue flower pattern piece and glue dot to the center of the flowers.

Step 4: Outline the edges of the white & freehand circles.

### Step 5: Lid

Take off handle using Heavy Duty Scissors or Tweezers by opening the lid & lifting the metal up from the tin. Round the corners of the green pattern piece and adhere to the top of the lid. Attach 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces of ribbon to handle. Attach handle back to lid.
